8. Nudity by campers must promote...

9. Nudity by campers must not be...
 - ☹ Uncomfortable

10. Participate fully. Don't sit on the sidelines.
11. Be nude. Activities must be...

 - ☺ Educational
 - ☺ Stretching – physically, mentally, and intellectually
 - ☺ Fun
 - ☺ Thought provoking
 - ☺ Cooperative – teamwork
 - ☺ Comfortable
 - ☺ Social
12. Nudity is expected. Exceptions only for...
 - ☺ Menstrual cycles
 - ☺ Weather permitting
 - ☺ Shoes
 - ☺ Sun over-exposure
 - ☺ Off-campus trips
 - ☺ Bugs
 - ☺ Safety
13. Towels must not be substitute for clothes.
14. Function's clothes should not serve...
 - ☹ Sexual allure
 - ☹ Affiliations – gangs, etc.
15. Stay out of kitchen and other unauthorized areas.
16. Be courteous to others while applying bug sprays and lotions.
17. Do not leave designated area without permission.
18. Use “buddy system” when outside camp area.
